For Immediate Release: Race Results - P1 AquaX / Round 2 / Daytona Beach, FL

"King D" takes control of the Pro Enduro championship!

The P1 AquaX Pro Enduro championship rolled into Daytona Beach for round 2 where Florida native Dustin Farthing was dominant aboard his Yamaha WaveRunner.



The #79 FX SVHO powered to holeshots in all 3 motos and led all 90 minutes of the races; with exception when a rogue wave ripped out his lanyard on the final lap of moto 2.

After a 1-2-1 for the weekend, Dustin Farthing leads the championship early by 23 points.

The younger Yamaha hotshot, Deven Farthing (#6), was competitive in each moto but had some bad luck in the early motos. Despite the difficulties he was

able to stay composed and finished 2nd in the third moto. He sits only 9 points from 4th overall in the championship, with still 6 motos remaining.

In the AM 300 class Talan Farthing (#521) got his first taste of the rough waters of Daytona. The first heat would be a "learning moto" to start the day. Once he had some experience to draw from he was able to show the Yamaha WaveRunner's potential en route to a dominant in moto 2, winning by 25 seconds. He now sits 4th in the championship standings.
